

THE 1902 'CHARRON' ARMoured CAR

No later than on 1902 did the C.G.V. company start to study the armoured cars. The model that was presented at the Automobile Show of that year is the first known French armoured engine.

Actually, it is the adaptation of an ordinary car's armoured rear bucket seat. The armament is a 8 mm Hotchkiss machine gun.

This vehicle was tested during the 1903 manoeuvres.
